Grüner Veltliner, Little Cricket

Pannon, Hungary

Highly recommended by Mara due to her Hungarian heritage. "No self-respecting restaurant wine list, whether in New York or Hong Kong, can afford to be without at least one example," Jancis Robinson. Little Cricket 'Grü-Ve' from Pannon, Hungary is delicate with notes of citrus - you may detect aromas of white pepper on the nose - a classic trait.

Janare Falanghina, Sannio Beneventano

Campania, Italy

Sprightly and vivid on the palate with notes of pear, white peaches, lemongrass and orange blossom. Lean-bodied but with a light honey-tinged texture adding great balance on a mineral finish.

Esprit de Crès Ricards Marsanne Roussanne

Languedoc, France

While Jo and Mara have been indulging and discovering wines this one truly stands out as one of our new favourites for you to try. Sitting on some of the finest soils and terroirs of the Languedoc, Château Cres Ricards produces truly standout and stunningly good wines. Showing a Burgundian focus and intensity, laced by white flowers and honeysuckle with a vanilla and apricot influenced finish.

MiMi Côtes de Provence Rosé

Provence, France

Provence specialists Vins Breban's flagship wine from the best vineyards within the region. MiMi is a mouth-watering rosé, oozing fresh summery fruit flavours in perfect harmony. Presented in a beautiful crested bottle utilising a reusable 'Vinolok' glass stopper closure.

Red

Tbilvino 'Iveriuli' Saperavi

Kakheti, Georgia

After insightful recommendations from Jo and Mara this wine left its own footprint for future generations to come. Comes highly recommended by local customers too. Take a journey back to the origins of wine. Georgia is one of the world's oldest wine-producing regions and in Kakheti, the Tbilvino winery is making delicious wines from indigenous ancient varieties like this Saperavi. A dry, fruity and medium-bodied red - there are aromas of cherry, vanilla and almonds that turn into a rich and warming flavour of mulberries.

Yerevan Areni/Karmrahyut, Winemaker's Blend Red

Armenia

"Recommended" to Tony by a wise old lady busy emptying the shelves of this at the wine merchants. It's an excellent red from Armenia that's quite unique but rather hard to explain why. Given the price it's absolutely worth discovering and then indulging. Fresh and juicy red with cherries and an attractive peppery character on the plate. Interesting wine from vineyards at over 1000 metres.

Massaya 'Le Colombier'

Bekaa Valley, Lebanon

Spicy notes with ripe, meaty, blackberry and red fruits and a touch of chocolate. This supple, round wine is from an exciting French-Lebanese collaboration, which owns vineyards at an altitude of 1,000 metres in the Bekaa Valley.

Avant Garde Pinot Noir, Domaine Carneros

Napa Valley California, USA

Established in 1987 by Champagne house Taittinger, Domaine Carneros produce delightfully aromatic Pinot Noir alongside their famed sparkling wines. Made very much in a Burgundian style, but a tad more silky and ripe. Fermented in small open-topped tanks prior to ageing for eight months in French oak barrels. An abundance of cherry and raspberry fruit on the nose, whilst the silky smooth palate is full of bright, spiced fresh fruit.

Sparkling

Gouguenheim Malbec Bubbles, Sparkling Rosé Extra Brut

Mendoza, Argentina

This characterful sparkler is full of delicate red fruit aromas and flavours of strawberries, bright cherries with a lovely fresh juiciness on the palate, beautiful balance and tiny bubbles.
